**C**ox & King offers a **Mt. Everest & Nepal** private four-day, three-night tour that includes a two-hour roundtrip helicopter flight to Mt. Everest, the highest peak in the Himalayan Mountain Range at 29,035 feet. Accompanied by expert Mt. Everest summiteers, the tour group passes close to the face of the snow-covered Himalayas, landing at the remote Tengboche Monastery. Two days of the trip are devoted to touring the beautiful Kathmandu Valley, and the tour includes Durbar Square, the ancient temple complex of Bodinath; and the medieval town of Bhaktapur, where artisans practice their native crafts. Guests dine at local Nepalese spots such as Rumdoodles, a restaurant well-known to mountaineers. Dwarika’s Hotel, a deluxe, historic hotel in Kathmandu recently featured in the book *Hip Hotels: Orient*, is home base for the three nights.
